2. **Class of event:**

UCI class-2 Men, Women
 The race will be run under UCI regulations.
 Only the UCI scale of penalties will be applied.

3. **UCI Rankings:**

The event is in UCI class 2 and, in accordance with Appendix 4 of Part5 of the UCI regulations, points will be awarded as follows for the UCI Cyclo-Cross Rankings:

Men Elite: 40, 30, 20, 15, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 and 1 points to the 10 first riders of the final classification.

Women: 40, 30, 20, 15, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 and 1 points to the 10 first riders of the final classification.

4. **License Control:**

License control is opened from 10:30 to 11:20 for Elite Women and 10:30 to 13:20 for Elite Men on November 25, 2016 at the race head quarter. Body bib number and two shoulder bib numbers will be handed to riders at the registration desk next to the license control.

	The Official ceremony shall take place within 10 minutes after the last rider finishes. Elite Women and Elite Men ceremony will take place together.
