
Location

Permitting; Rules and Regulations

UCI Races held under UCI permits and regulations. The UCI scale of penalties shall apply.

Eligibility

All racers must have a valid license with a UCI ID delivered by a National Federation recognized by the UCI.

- Elite Men: Open to riders whose 2019-2020 racing age is 19 and above (born in year 2001 and before)
- Elite Women: Open to riders whose 2019-2020 racing age is 17 and above (born in year 2003 and before)
- Men Junior: Take note that a UCI ID is required.

UCI Rankings:

The event is in UCI class 1 and, in accordance with Appendix 4 of Part5 of the UCI regulations, points will be awarded as follows for the UCI Cyclo-Cross Rankings:

Elite Men and Women: 80, 60, 40, 30, 25, 20, 17, 15, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2, and 1 point to the 15 first riders of the final classification.

Junior Men:10, 6, 4, 2, and 1 point to the 5 first riders of the final classification. Junior Men may race in conjunction with other relevant category.

License Control, Number Pick Up Schedule and Location

License control is opened from 11:00 to 12:00 for Elite Men, Women and Junior Men on November 23rd, 2019 at the race registration building. Body bib number and two shoulder bib numbers will be handed to riders at the registration desk next to the license control.

Chip Return

Chip must be returned following the finish line by, or at the 80% point if you are removed from the race. It is the rider's responsibility to make sure chip is returned. Failure to return a chip will result in a replacement charge of 150 CHF from the UCI.

Staging Protocol and Start Order

In accordance with UCI Rule 5.1.043 start order will be:

- 1) As per the most recently published UCI cyclo-cross individual classification of the current season.
- 2) Unclassified riders: Random generated start order

A doctor and nurse will be placed at the aid station next to the Headquarters. Ambulance will also be at the site.

Map and the profile of the Circuit:

Distance: 2.9km Start straight: 140m

Double Pit

Obstacles include a fly-over, a pair of barriers, and a trench.

NOTE: Men Junior use Long Course (noted as C2,CM1,Elite Only on Map below)
