Permitting; Rules and Regulations

Permits

UCI Races held under UCI permits and regulations. The UCI scale of penalties shall apply.

Eligibility

All racers must have a valid license with a UCI ID delivered by a National Federation recognized by the UCI.

- Men Elite: Open to riders whose 2023-2024 racing age is 19 and above (born in year 2005 and before)
- Women Elite: Open to riders whose 2023-2024 racing age is 17 and above (born in year 2007 and before)
- Men Junior: Open to riders aged whose 2023-2024 racing age is 17 to 18. (born in year 2006 and 2007)

UCI Rankings:

The event is in UCI class 2 and, in accordance with Appendix 4 of Part 5 of the UCI regulations, points will be awarded as follows for the UCI Cyclo-Cross Rankings:

Elite Men and Women: 40, 30, 20, 15, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2, and 1 point to the 10 first riders of the final classification. Men Junior :30,20,15,12,10,8,6,4,2, and 1 point to the 10 first riders of the final classification.

Registration

Pre-registration for ALL races is available online at sportentry. For nonresidents of Japan. please contact the organizer.

License Control, Number Pick Up Schedule and Location

License control is open from 10:00 to 10:30 for Men Junior. 10:30 to 11:30 for Elite Men and Women on 19th, 2023 at the race registration building. Body bib number and two shoulder bib numbers will be handed to riders at the registration desk next to the license control.



TIMING, SCORING AND RESULTS:

Timing and scoring will be done using a computer program by our timing staff. In addition to the staff and computer program, a video and photo camera will also be present at the finish line. The timing equipment and staff will be located in the official's tent.

Results will be posted on the Results Board in the registration desk. Results will also be posted on the race website at www.nobeyamacyclocross.cc/





Timing Chip Mount Instruction

Timing Chip Return

Timing Chip must be returned following the finish line by, or at the 80% point if you are removed from the race. It is **the rider's responsibility to make sure the chip is returned**. Failure to return a chip will result in a replacement charge of 150 CHF from the organizer.

Staging Protocol and Start Order

In accordance with UCI Rule 5.1.043 start order will be:

- 1. As per the most recently published UCI cyclo-cross individual ranking of the current season (or the final ranking of the previous season if no ranking has yet been published for the current season),
- 2. Unclassified riders: by drawing lots

First aid:

A doctor and nurse will be placed at the aid station next to the Headquarters.
